Beaubassin-est Tree of Hope Lighting at the Père-Edgar-T.-LeBlanc School

The Beaubassin-est Rural Community, in collaboration with the Père-Edgar-T.-LeBlanc (PETL) School, will light the Tree of Hope on Wednesday, November 16 at 6:30 p.m. in front of the school in Grand-Barachois. Mayor Louise Landry and school principal Pierrette Gallant invite people to attend this 10th illumination of the Tree of Hope in Beaubassin-est.

The two ambassadors of the Provincial Cabinet of the Tree of Hope, Rejean Després and Isabelle Thériault, will be on site, and two cancer survivors will light the tree. Hot chocolate and cookies will be served, and a choir made up of students from the school will perform some songs.

Many initiatives are carried out by community groups to raise funds, and all the money raised is intended for the Provincial Campaign. The results of the campaign will be announced during a special broadcast on Saturday, November 26 between 10 a.m. and 12 p.m. by Radio-Canada Acadie, on ICI Première.
