Several new activities in Beaubassin-est in 2020

Several new activities will take place in Beaubassin-est during the year 2020. It will start on Saturday, February 15 with a Winter Day at the Haute-Aboujagane Community Center.

In March, there will be a free tax preparation service for people with an income of \$ 32,000 or less, on March 11 at the Shemogue Golden Age Club and on March 18 at the Saint-André-LeBlanc. There will be a Multicultural Evening at the Saint-André-LeBlanc Center on March 27.

Community cleanup day will be organized for May 30, but this year it will be Ecovision 2025 Day and the activity will take place in collaboration with Cap-Pelé and Shediac. Also on May 30, there will be a Free Document Destruction Day (Shred-it) at the Shemogue Golden Age Club. On June 20, there will be a Golf Tournament at the Pine Needles for the benefit of the PETL school playground, and the Summer Camps will run from June 28 to August 21.

In July, there will be a Summer Festival in Haute-Aboujagane on July 4, followed by the Saint-André-LeBlanc Summer Festival on July 5. The “Célébrons nos quais” music evenings will begin on July 9 and end on August 27 with a special evening including fireworks. The shows will be presented at the Robichaud and Petit-Cap wharves.

The Grand-bazar-à-choix will be back on Saturday, August 22 at the Grand-Barachois Hall, while the Beaubassin Community Party should take place on August 23 at the municipal building, and a Beaubassin-est Ambassadors Evening is scheduled for September 17. Firefighters will have their BBQ at the Haute-Aboujagane Firehall in October during Fire Prevention Week, while the Halloween Party will be held in late October. In November, a Christmas Market is planned, as well as the Tree of Hope Lighting, and the programming will end with the Christmas Party in December.
