### Canceled activities in Beaubassin-est

According to the most recent version of the renewed and revised Mandatory Order COVID-19 of the province of New Brunswick, large gatherings such as festivals and concerts are prohibited through December 31, 2020. So, in order to respect the measures in place, the Beaubassin-est Rural Community announces that the following activities announced in the Activities 2020 brochure are canceled:

- Plant Exchange on Sunday, May 24 at the Grand-Barachois Hall;
- Community Cleanup Day on Saturday, May 30 in Beaubassin-est, Cap-Pelé and Shediac;
- Documents Destruction Day on Saturday, May 30 at the Shemogue Golden Age Club;
- CINÉMACADIE Acadian Film Festival on June 12 to 14 at the Barachois Historic Church;
- Golf Tournament for the Père-Edgar-T.-LeBlanc School Playground on Saturday, June 20 at the Pine Needles Golf Club in Haute-Aboujagane;
- Beaubassin-est Summer Camps from June 29 to August 21;
- Summer Music Festival on Saturday, July 4 at the Haute-Aboujagane Community Center;
- Summer Festival on Sunday, July 5 at the Saint-André-LeBlanc Center;
- Beaubassin-est Garden Tour on Sunday, July 19;
- Let's Celebrate our Wharves Concerts from July 9 to August 27 at the Robichaud and Petit-Cap wharves;
- Arts Celebration / Passion Percussions on August 21, 22 and 23 at the Barachois Historic Church;
- L'Grand bazar-à-choix on Saturday, August 22 at the Grand-Barachois Hall;
- Community Celebration on Sunday, August 23 at the Beaubassin-est municipal building;
- Beaubassin-est Ambassadors Night on Thursday, September 17 at the Barachois Historic Church; and
- Antique Picnic Live a moment of the past on Sunday, September 19 on the Barachois Church Grounds.

If possible, some activities will be postponed to future dates. We will announce new dates when the situation returns to normal. In addition, for the time being, the monthly breakfasts served at the Grand-Barachois Hall and at the Saint-André-LeBlanc Center are also canceled until further notice, as well as all other activities in all community centers and Golden Age Clubs of the rural community. We will make another announcement in a few weeks for the activities planned for the following months.
