### Cap-Pelé and Beaubassin-est propose to become Cap-Acadie

The transition committee proposes that entity 38, which will bring together the Beaubassin-est Rural Community and the Village of Cap-Pelé, bear the name of Cap-Acadie (our advertising identification named Regional Town). Committee members arrived at this choice of name after asking students from Donat-Robichaud, Père-Edgar-T.-LeBlanc and Louis-J.-Robichaud schools to submit suggestions. They received 48 name submissions and then brought together community leaders to come up with a shortlist of potential names and choose their preferences. The members of the transition committee then ratified the choice of name voted on by the community group.

The work for the future amalgamation is progressing well and the stakeholders have also agreed on the composition of the council of the new entity of more than 9,000 citizens. They propose that the Regional Town of Cap-Acadie have a Mayor and eight Councillors voted at large. Remember that the municipal elections will take place on Monday, November 28, 2022 and that the new elected Council will take office on January 1, 2023.
