The Beaubassin-est Rural Community has made an agreement with Marché Au Corner - Cap-Pelé Freshmart to offer home delivery service at a cost of \$3.50 for the residents of Trois-Ruisseaux, Petit-Cap, Portage, Saint-André-LeBlanc, Cormier-Village and Robichaud. This service makes it possible to limit contacts between people, in particular for people who must follow the instructions of self-isolation due to a return from travel outside the province, and thus limit the spread of COVID -19 in the community.

The Council wants to offer an affordable service to help people in self-isolation get essential items without leaving the house. "We are pleased to conclude an agreement with a grocery store who serves the population of Beaubassin-est by offering an accessible delivery service for our residents," said the mayor, Ronnie Duguay.
