The Beaubassin-est Rural Community has reached an agreement with the Knights of Columbus of Cap-Pelé (Council 9178) to offer a free home delivery service of prescriptions from the Cap-Pelé Guardian and Jean Coutu pharmacies for residents of Shemogue, Portage, Trois-Ruisseaux, Petit-Cap and Saint-André, for an indefinite period due to the COVID-19 pandemic. To plan a delivery, please call the pharmacies at the following numbers: Guardian 506-577-4716 and Jean Coutu 506-332-9000 (press option 5 or 7).

This service allows you to get essential items without leaving the house to avoid contact between people, especially for those who must follow the instructions of self-isolation due to a return trip from outside the province, thereby limiting the spread of COVID-19 in the community. "We are pleased that this community organization has decided to get involved with these pharmacies that serve the population, by offering a delivery service for our residents," said Mayor Ronnie Duguay.
