Distribution of native trees to residents of Beaubassin-est

On Saturday October 2, Beaubassin-est will distribute 60 native trees to its residents. You must reserve your tree by contacting Pete Belliveau at pete.belliveau@beaubassinest.ca or at 506-532-0730. There will be 20 red maples (4'-5'), 20 sugar maples (2'-3') and 20 red oaks (2'-3').

You can pick up your tree on Saturday October 2 between 8:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. at the municipal building located at 1709 Route 133 in Grand-Barachois. In addition to a free tree to plant in your yard, you will receive a guide to native trees of the Acadian Forest that shows the steps to follow to plant a tree correctly.

This is an activity organized as part of the EcoVision2025 Strategy, in collaboration with Vision H2O and the Shediac Bay Watershed Association. The initiative aims to promote the planting of native trees in order to contribute to the quality of the environment in our communities. The Village of Cap-Pelé and the Town of Shediac will also offer trees to their residents.
