### **Beaubassin-est invests \$ 500,000 in the Cap-Pelé Intergenerational Community Center project**

The Beaubassin-est Rural Community Council presented a check for \$ 500,000 to the Village of Cap-Pelé for the Intergenerational Community Center project. "We are extremely proud to invest in this project which will be beneficial for our residents," said Mayor Louise Landry.

Thanks to this investment, citizens of Beaubassin-est will be able to take advantage of these facilities at no additional cost. "We wanted the services and programs offered in this new infrastructure to be accessible to residents of Beaubassin-est at the same rates as those of Cap-Pelé," adds Mrs. Landry. "Our residents will not have to pay non-residents registration fees for sports, such as hockey or ringette, or for other services and programs that will be offered at the Cap-Pelé Intergenerational Community Center."

This new partnership will even allow Beaubassin-est residents to take advantage of the same rates as Cap-Pelé residents for passes to the Aboiteau Beach. "By negotiating this type of regional partnership, we are able to offer our citizens access to the infrastructure of neighboring municipalities, and to focus our efforts on other projects that will benefit the entire community," specifies Mrs. Landry.

"Several businesses and residents of Beaubassin-est have also made important contributions to this project and we encourage everybody to make a contribution to the campaign," concludes the Mayor. The goal of this fundraising campaign is to raise 4.1 million dollars for the construction of a 13.5 million dollars intergenerational center in Cap-Pelé to serve the greater region.
