## Beaubassin-est Firefighters take advantage of Fire Prevention Week to remind you to be careful when cooking

The Beaubassin-est Fire Department encourages all residents to embrace the 2020 Fire Prevention Week theme, "Serve Up Fire Safety in the Kitchen". This year, the week is October 4 to 10, 2020 and the campaign works to educate everyone about simple but important actions they can take to keep themselves and those around them safe.

Cooking is the leading cause of home fires and home fire injuries in Canada. The majority of reported home fires started in the kitchen. Most home fires start with the ignition of food or other cooking materials.

Cooking fires can be prevented by staying in the kitchen while cooking, using a timer, and avoiding distractions such as electronics or TV. Those are steps everyone can take to keep families safe in their homes.

Here a safety tips to keep you from having a cooking fire:

- Never leave cooking food unattended. Stay in the kitchen while you are frying, grilling or broiling food. If you have to leave, even for a short time, turn off the stove.
- If you are simmering, baking, roasting, or boiling food, check it regularly. Remain in the home while food is cooking, and use a timer to remind you that you're cooking.
- You have to be alert when cooking. You won't be alert if you are sleepy, have taken medicine or drugs, or have consumed alcohol that makes you drowsy.
- Always keep an oven mitt and pan lid nearly when you're cooking. If a small grease fire starts, slide the lid over the pan to smother the flame. Turn off the burner, and leave the pan covered until it is completely cool.
- Have a "kid-free zone" of at least 1 metre around the stove and areas where hot food or drink is prepared or caried.
