## Beaubassin-est invites its community organizations to submit grant applications

Organizations and community groups have until March 31 to submit the Grant Application Form to the Beaubassin-est Rural Community. The form is available on the municipality's website at beaubassinest.ca, under the "Citizens / Community Life, Organizations, Community Facilities" tab, or at the Beaubassin-est office.

Council assesses grant applications twice a year, with deadlines for applications being March 31 and October 31. Grant applications are evaluated according to the following evaluation criteria:

- Grant applications are made by a non-profit community organization / group that serves the population of Beaubassin-est;
- The requested grants must help to organize specific activities of the organization / group that will have an impact on the community;
- Priority will be given to grant applications that will be used to help people in need in the municipality.

## Reimbursement of administrative costs

The municipality can also reimburse certain administrative costs to community groups. These fees include: document approval, zoning confirmation, request for waiver, temporary permit request, requests for similar or compatible, letter of compliance, and construction/development permit. Organizations must complete the Refund Request Form and provide proof of payment of fees.
