Beaubassin-est gives \$10,525 in grants

The Beaubassin-est Rural Community approved grants totaling \$10,525 during the regular council meeting on Monday, November 18. "Members of Council are very happy to be able to contribute to these projects and organizations that have a beneficial impact for the entire community," said Beaubassin-est Mayor Ronnie Duguay.

A donation of \$3,200 was given to Old River Productions and Legal Services to help fund a Mi'kmaq-Acadien Winter Cultural Exchange. This activity will be held on January 25-27 for elementary school students from Elsipoqtog, Mgr-François-Bourgeois in Shediac and Père-Edgar-T.-LeBlanc in Grand-Barachois. These funds come from the budget of the Cultural Policy.
