WHEREAS the municipality must appoint a Clerk and a Treasurer according to section 74 of the Municipalities Act;

WHEREAS the Council wishes to allow the persons named below to remain present at the meeting because they must document the decision-making process of the Council;

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the municipality enters into a service agreement with Yves M. Leger, on the conditions negotiated, from January 1st until the hiring of a new CAO, in order to fulfill the duties of Clerk of the municipality and any other tasks that may be delegated to him;

AND BE IT RESOLVED THAT the following individuals be appointed to the positions listed on a temporary basis from January 1st until the hiring of a new person who will take over the position of CAO;

Charline Landry is appointed Acting CAO and Acting Treasurer, in addition to holding the title of Deputy Clerk;

Carole Friolet-Landry is appointed Acting Assistant CAO and Acting Assistant Treasurer;

Yves M. Leger is Acting Clerk.

AND BE IT RESOLVED THAT the hiring of a new person to take over the position of CAO will restore the regular staff to their normal duties and titles.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Charline Landry's credit card limit remains at \$ 5,000. When a new person is hired to take over the position of CAO, the usual limits will be reinstated, namely \$ 5,000 for CAO and \$ 500 for Charline Landry.
