Be careful on the Beaubassin-est playgrounds and trails

The Beaubassin-est Rural Community advises the population that its play structures are now open. However, people are encouraged to follow public health guidelines by practicing two-meter social distancing when using play structures and on trails. It should also be noted that the playgrounds are at your own risk and we strongly recommend bringing your own disinfectant since the structures, benches and trash cans will not be disinfected.

This applies to the bird watching site at Boudreau-Ouest, to the Grand-Barachois walking trail, to the trail and playground at the Haute-Aboujagane Community Center, to the trails at the Haute-Aboujagane Hunting and Fishing Club, to the trails, playground and tennis court at the Cormier-Village Cultural and Sports Center, to the playground at the Saint-André-LeBlanc Center and to the playground at the Shemogue Golden Age Club. Please note, however, that the Shemogue playground is closed until further notice due to construction.
