Restrictions in Beaubassin-est during the red phase

According to the Beaubassin-est operational plan during the pandemic, the municipal office will be closed to the public while the zone is in the Red Alert Level of New Brunswick's COVID-19 recovery plan. People who wish to join the office can do so by phone at 506-532-0730 or by email at info@beaubassinest.ca. We will be able to answer your questions and settle certain issues, and if you require documentation, we will send it by email, fax or mail.

As for the snowshoe loan program, it will be available, while following the instructions of Public Health. "We want to encourage people to practice outdoor activities with people who are part of your family bubble," says Mayor Ronnie Duguay. He does point out, however, that if you are going on a trail, be sure to wear a mask and maintain a physical distance of at least two meters from people around you and remember to wash your hands often during the course of the day.

To borrow snowshoes, you must call 506-532-0730 so that we can collect all the necessary information, and then you must send us a copy of a driver's license. A specific time will be set for the collection and return of the snowshoes, which will be done without contact outside. Once the snowshoes have been returned, all equipment will be sanitized and will not be used for 48 hours.
