Beaubassin-est offers a \$1,000 scholarship

Students from Beaubassin-est have until April 30th at 4 pm to submit a scholarship application. The draw for the \$ 1,000 scholarship will be made during a council meeting. Any person that meets the following criteria may apply for the scholarship by completing the necessary form and bringing it to the municipality. Applicants must:

- be permanent residents of the municipality;
- have obtained a high school diploma or be on the list of graduates for the current year;
- continue training in first year of an undergraduate program in a post-secondary institution and not have pursued post-secondary education before; and
- be 25 years old or less.

The winner will receive the scholarship in January 2021 after presenting a document from the postsecondary institution certifying enrollment in a program of study that meets the criteria and his readmission for the second term of the school year. If the training is completed before the month of January 2021, a document certifying that the student has met the requirements of the training program will be required before receiving the scholarship.
