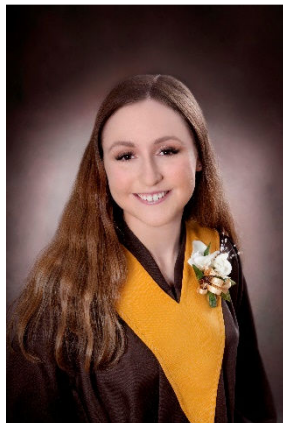
Beaubassin-est will give a \$1000 scholarship to Mireille Léger from Portage

Mireille Léger from Portage is the winner of the \$1000 scholarship from the Beaubassin-est Rural Community. She was selected in the random draw among all submissions during the Council's public meeting on Monday, May 25.

She will receive the scholarship in January 2021 after presenting a document from the postsecondary institution certifying enrollment in a program of study that meets the criteria and her readmission for the second term of the school year. This year, the municipality received a total of 23 scholarship application forms. Of these, 18 applications were eligible for the draw.

Students from Beaubassin-est enrolling in the first year of an undergraduate program have until April 30th of each year to apply for the scholarship.
